



Dear Prospective Gold Digger:

Thank you for your recent inquiry about the Family Motor Coach Association, Gold Diggers Chapter. We just celebrated our 30th year anniversary as an FMCA chapter. We are chartered as a small chapter with a maximum of forty (40) rigs. We are delighted that you are interested in our group.

The Gold Diggers Chapter is located in and around the Gold Country of Northern California, specifically the Sacramento region. All of our rallies are held within a 150-mile radius of the City of Sacramento. We do, on occasion and with the membership approval, go beyond the 150-mile radius. As an example, we have visited the Durango RV Park in Red Bluff and Heritage RV Park in Corning. We also attend the FMCA Western Regional rally in Indio every January where we serve as volunteers; this allows our group to park in prime locations at the fairgrounds.

We require that prospective members attend two of our RV outings before becoming members of our chapter. There is an initial one-time application fee of \$20.00 and annual dues of \$15.00 payable in October of each year thereafter. New members admitted into the chapter are presented a Gold Diggers flag, membership list, by laws, and standing rules. You will also begin receiving our newsletter, Gold Digger Nuggets, sent by e-mail quarterly. You will also be assigned a sponsor to help you through early meetings and make you feel comfortable by answering any questions you may have.
