SECRETARY'S REPORT FMCA GOLD DIGGERS

September 6, 2023 Feather Falls KOA Oroville, CA

The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 9:28 a.m. by President Al Calbreath. Officers present were Betty Smith Secretary; Galan Smith, Acting 1st Vice President/Wagon Master, and Darlene Calbreath, National Director.

<u>Secretary's Report</u>: Betty read the minutes of the May 25, 2023 meeting, and they were approved as written (with corrections).

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Al reported, for Suzanne Salter, that we started out 2023 with \$6,675.00, and we now have \$6,107.00.

<u>Rallies</u>: Unfortunately, the Grass Valley Rally, July 19 – 22 had to be called off for lack of a Trail Boss. Al reported that the Lodi rally will be November 30, 2023 with us leaving December 3. Suzanne will be bringing a full turkey dinner, and we will also be having prime rib one night. The motion was seconded and carried. FMCA will be having their annual Tucson rally March 19 and 20, 2024.

Indio 2024: Al reported that we need to have 6 rigs in order to keep our preferred parking under the palm trees and our three nights of free camping like we have for the last 20 years. Darlene went over all the things the Gold Diggers are expected to do at the rally, assemble the "Welcome" bags and hand them out, Chapter Fair. Plus, someone needs to Trail Boss. We will be having pizza Saturday night, the Volunteer dinner on Tuesday night and dinner at camp on Sunday and Monday. The folks who will be going so far are the Donatellis, Garcias, DeZonias, Blalocks, and possibly the Smiths and Yarberrys. Al will be contacting the Yarberrys as we need to let FMCA know if we will have the required number of RVs and will
